Instagram Direct

The Instagram Direct Feature allows you to share a private video or photo to friends, without posting it to the public timeline. On the inbox on the home screen, you can preview all shared videos and photos.

Location Feature

Instagram activates geotagging for your select photos and maps them where your followers can search by location. You can also toggle this feature on or off and deselect the photos that you don't want to map.

Photo Shooting and Editing

To capture a photo within the app, press on the plus sign (+) at the app's dashboard. You can now add a photo or video to your public feed. You can also upload a photo from your phone's storage

on this menu.

On capturing your photo, there are many editing tools within the app. On the edit screen, you can select from the 23-filter set, crop, adjust the contrast, sharpness, and brightness of your shot. By default, Instagram levels and rotates your shots automatically across the 3D axis.

Instagram Stories

Instagram bundles up your several selected photos into a story. The uploaded photos follow each other. You can tag your location and add stickers on these photos.

Live Video

Instagram streams live your video to the public feed. Your followers can tag or even comment on the live video. ### Review
